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C I R C U L A R

Ministry of Human Resource Development New Delhi has pointed out that the students are not performing favorably in subject Mathematics, Science, Social Science and English and also observed that the dropout rate is very high.


In view of the above observation and with the objective of bringing about quantitative improvement in the academically weak students the Government High School under RMSA shall be taken up remedial teaching for academically weak students of class IX in Mathematics, Science, Social-Science and English subject. Remedial teaching aims to provide additional help to students who at the time of transition from class VIII to Class IX do not achieve expected level of achievement.

The regular subject teacher from school will conduct regular remedial classes for weak students and must also conduct regular tests to review their level of learning. If the performance of the student in a particular subject area/topic is unsatisfactory. The regular subject teacher will highlight area in which the student is weak in his/her subject on case to case basis giving details of efforts put in by the teacher for improvement of the students. The Head of the institution/DDO should appoint a remedial teacher to improve the performance of students by strictly following the criteria given below:

- a) The remedial teacher appointed should not be employed on regular basis in any Government/ Government Aided/ Central Government High School/ Higher Secondary School.
- b) The remedial teacher should have good experience in teaching respective subject; the retired Headmasters/teachers expert in that particular subject may be appointed by going through their qualification.
- c) In case of non-availability of experience teachers as detailed at (b) above, the unemployed youth in the locality having required educational qualification may be requisitioned.

- d) The MHRD has given approval for only 1010 students @ of Rs.500/- students for State of Goa. The remuneration charges of remedial teacher and other expenses shall be incurred from this amount.
- e) The Headmaster should take prior approval from this office for implementation of the Programme.
- f) The regular subject teacher of the school must conduct the unit-wise achievement tests and the record of the same shall be maintained by the Head of the school in the form of register (Performa shall be communicated subsequently). Based on the achievement test, the head of the school shall plan and implement the remedial classes.
- g) The monthly report and action taken plan should be submitted to this office for further necessary action.

The necessary instructions in this regard may be given to all the staff /teachers in your school. Your personal intervention in this matter will help in achieving the goal of improving the overall quality of education.
